

Reentry Backpack Program

Community Partners in Action's Reentry Backpack Program provides participants at our Hartford and Waterbury Reentry Welcome Centers with a free, gender-tailored backpack filled with toiletries and other essential items. The Centers assist adults returning to Greater Hartford or Waterbury after prison and those already living in those communities who have a criminal history.

The reentry backpacks allow participants to immediately address their most basic needs---hygiene, clothing, food and transportation. Each Center gives out 25 to 30 free reentry backpacks per month.

If you would like to donate reentry backpacks or conduct a Reentry Backpack Drive at your work, church, organization or community, the following are the core and additional optional items we include in each one. We ask that the backpacks be dropped off at the Centers already assembled.
